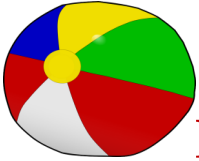

Pool Opens ~ Sat. May 25th

Hours – May 26th thru Mid – August:

Monday: POOL CLOSED (excluding Holidays)

Tues., Wed., Thur., Fri., & Sat.: 10am – 9pm

Sunday: 1pm – 9pm

Unforeseen Closings:

- Inclement Weather Alerts (Lightning within 6-8 miles, severe storms, and/or tornadoes). Pool will remain closed for 30 minutes after last lightning is seen or thunder is heard.
- Pool contamination (fecal matter, vomit, diarrhea). Pool will remain closed 30 minutes or overnight depending on contamination.
- Pool closings require EVERYONE to leave the pool area.

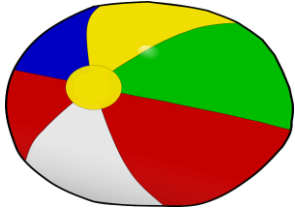

VOW Tennis Courts Rules

Prime Time Hours (no instruction/coaching)

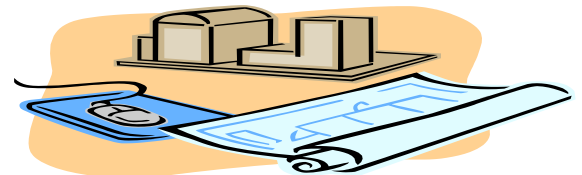
Mon, Wed, Fri & Sat – 5:00 pm to 10:00 pm

Sunday – 12:00 pm to 10:00 pm

1. For VOW members and 1 guest only. Guest must be accompanied by member.
2. No black soled shoes are allowed on the tennis court.
3. No activity other than tennis allowed. Absolutely no skating, skateboarding, bicycling, rollerblading or pets allowed.
4. Help keep court litter free. Players are asked to remove all litter from the courts upon leaving.
5. Court time is limited to 90 minutes when others are waiting to play.
6. No leaning, hanging, or jumping over the nets. No fence climbing.
7. Do not throw gravel onto courts.
8. Always close gate when you leave the courts.
9. Park gates are locked daily at 10:00pm
10. Offenders subject to suspension of privileges.
