SUBJECT TO SUSPENSION OF COURT PRIVILEGES

PURPOSE: To provide the maximum amount of playing time for VOW residents so that they may enjoy the tennis court facility and the opportunity that it provides for fun, exercise, and fellowship. Also, it is the intent of these rules to provide time for residents to have as their guest an instructor/coach for lessons as an added benefit of the facility to the VOW owners. Your cooperation with these rules is appreciated.

MEMBER REQUIREMENTS:

- All residents with dues paid and in good standing are eligible to use The Villages of Wellington Tennis Courts.
- Household residents are allowed to have one (1) guest at a time.
- Residents must be present with their guests at all times.
- Children under age 10 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- The member is responsible for their guest's behavior and rule compliance.
- eCard usage is electronically tracked to homeowners.

BEHAVIOR:

- Absolutely no skating, skateboard, bicycle or roller blades allowed on court surface.
- Always wear proper non-marking tennis shoes – no black soled shoes are allowed.
- No leaning, hanging or jumping over the nets. No fence climbing.
- Do not lean over nets to retrieve balls.
- Do not throw gravel or other debris onto courts.
- Any violation of tennis court rules is grounds for suspension of court privileges.

RULES:

- Court time limited to 90 minutes when others are waiting to play.
- No pets, no food and no glass allowed on the courts.
- Keep court litter free. Remove all litter from courts upon leaving.
- All players must abide by tennis code of conduct; particularly regarding the use of profanity.
- Always close the gate and turn off lights at departure.
- Park gates are locked daily at 10:00 PM.

VOW TENNIS COURT USE BY TENNIS INSTRUCTOR/TENNIS COACH:

- A VOW resident may use either a resident or non-resident tennis instructor/coach during non-prime time hours. Resident must be present on the court during the entire session.
- Access to the courts shall be by the authorized VOW resident recreation eCard.
- Instructor/coach must comply with court rules & regulations the same as any resident or guest.
- Resident instructors/coaches may not give lessons to non-residents at any time.
- Student limit per court: four (4), where at least two (2) are residents.
- Only one court to be used for instruction at a time.
- Prime time hours are designated times for resident non-instruction/coaching tennis play only. See prime time hours listed above.
